(1) Unveiling: Task Force Meth Tool Kit

After months of work by the Task Force, the NCAI Meth Task Force tool-kit will be available for the first time at the NCAI Mid-Year. (Until additional funds are raised they will be available at cost. But we estimate that will only be approximately \$125. Much of the contents will also be available on-line.)

(2) White House “Drug Czar” Scott Burns

Scott Burns from the White House’s Drug Czar’s office (The Office of National Drug Control Policy) will be joining us to discuss the White House’s efforts to deal with meth and substance abuse in Indian Country.

(3) An Alaskan Perspective on Meth: Mayor Edward Itta, Barrow, AK

With its remote villages and lack of access to law enforcement, Alaska has a unique set of problems in dealing with meth and substance abuse. Alaska leaders will share with the Task Force some of the problems and some of the creative solutions.

(4) National Anti Meth Media Campaign

The Partnership for a Drug Free America will be conducting separate focus groups with Alaskan communities this week, and providing the Task Force an update.

(5) Brainstorming and Planning for Upcoming DOJ and ONDCP National Meth Summit

The Department of Justice and the Office of National Drug Control Policy are hosting a National Meth Summit and tribal input is needed.
