The Subcommittee applied three different proposed budget scenarios to the data: Level funding of the FY2017 President's request (\$2.93 billion); 8% above the FY2017 President's request; and 10% above the President's request. The Subcommittee Report will be presented to the full TIBC body for their review, amendment and final approval before submission to the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs.
