Tribal Consultation on Tribal Set-Aside Funding from the Crime Victims Fund

The U.S. Department of Justice's Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) invites tribal leaders, representatives, and stakeholders to participate in a Tribal Consultation on Tribal Set-Aside Funding from the Federal Crime Victims Fund and how it should be programmed.

The purpose of the Consultation is to discuss victim services grant award programs for tribal communities; information about the administration of the FY2020 tribal set-aside funding; and how Tribal leaders recommend that the set-aside funding be administered.

An in-person consultation will be held on Wednesday, February 12, 2020, in conjunction with the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) 2020 Executive Council Winter Session at the Capital Hilton, 1001 16th Street NW, Washington, D.C. from 1:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. in the Congressional Room.
