# Grant Forecast for FY20\*

## (Oct. 1, 2019 to Sept. 30, 2020)

### Discretionary Grant Competitions: 4

- **Demonstration (Demo)** – Projects that develop or demonstrate the effectiveness of services to improve educational opportunities and achievement of Indian children and youth.
- **Professional Development (PD)** – Projects to increase the number of qualified Indian teachers and administrators serving Indian students.
- **Native American Language (NAL@ED)** – Projects that support schools in using Native American and Alaska Native languages as the primary language of instruction.
- **State Tribal Education Partnership (STEP)** – Projects to promote the coordination and collaboration of Tribal educational agencies (TEAs) with State educational agencies (SEAs) and Local education agencies (LEAs).

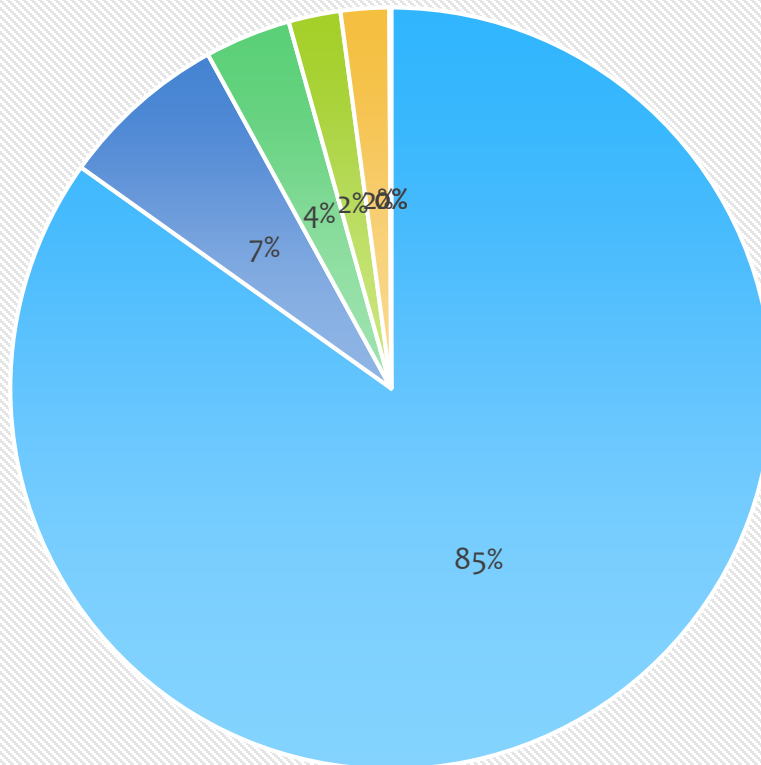
## Need for Peer Reviewers: **Summer 2020**

- \* Individuals with advanced education degrees and/or experience working with AI/AN communities are strongly desired as peer reviewers.
- \* Peer reviewers receive compensation of \$175 per application reviewed.

Total number of grantees = 1,314

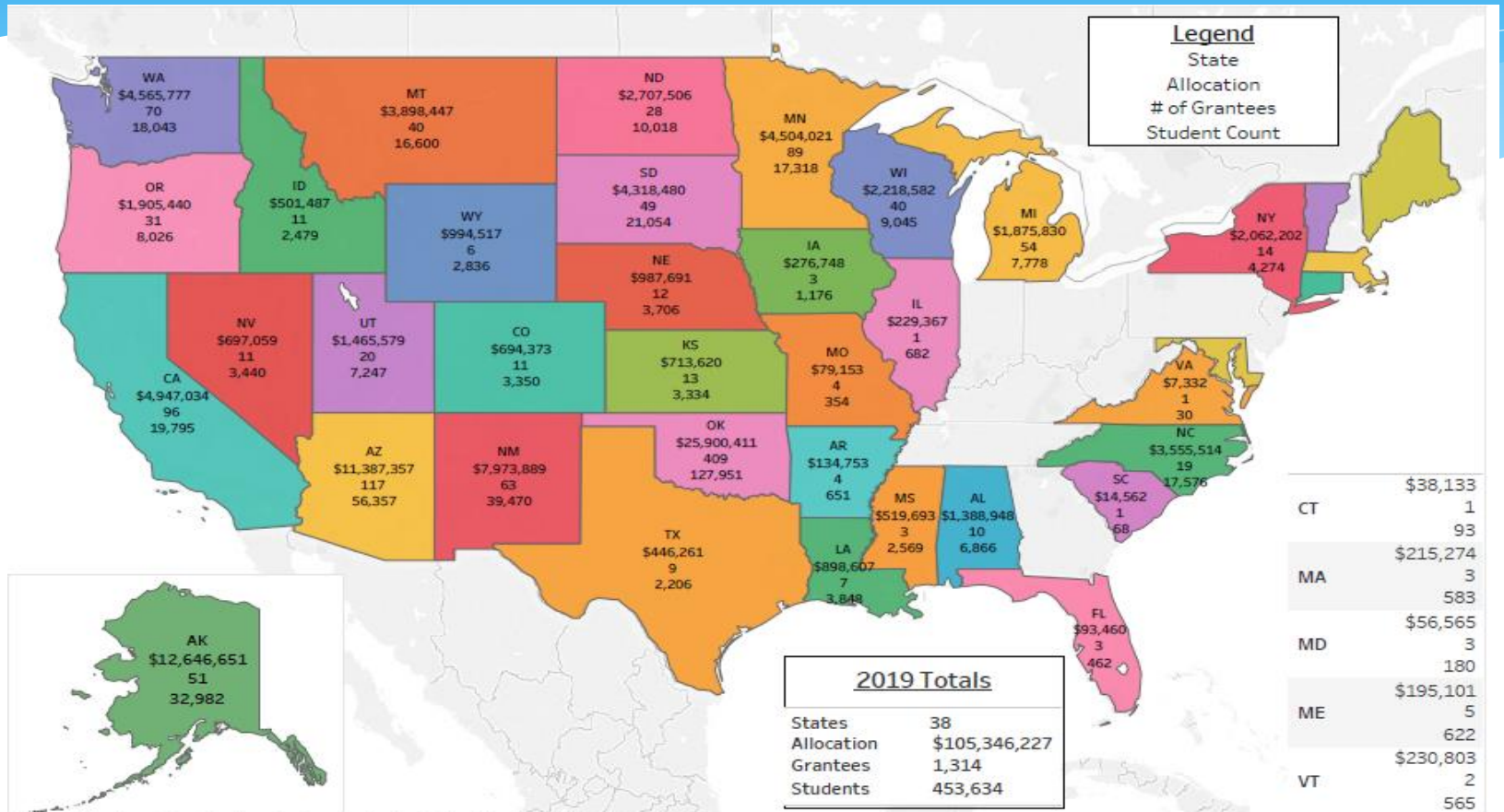


- LEA = 1115 (85%)

Total Number of Indian Students Served: 453,634

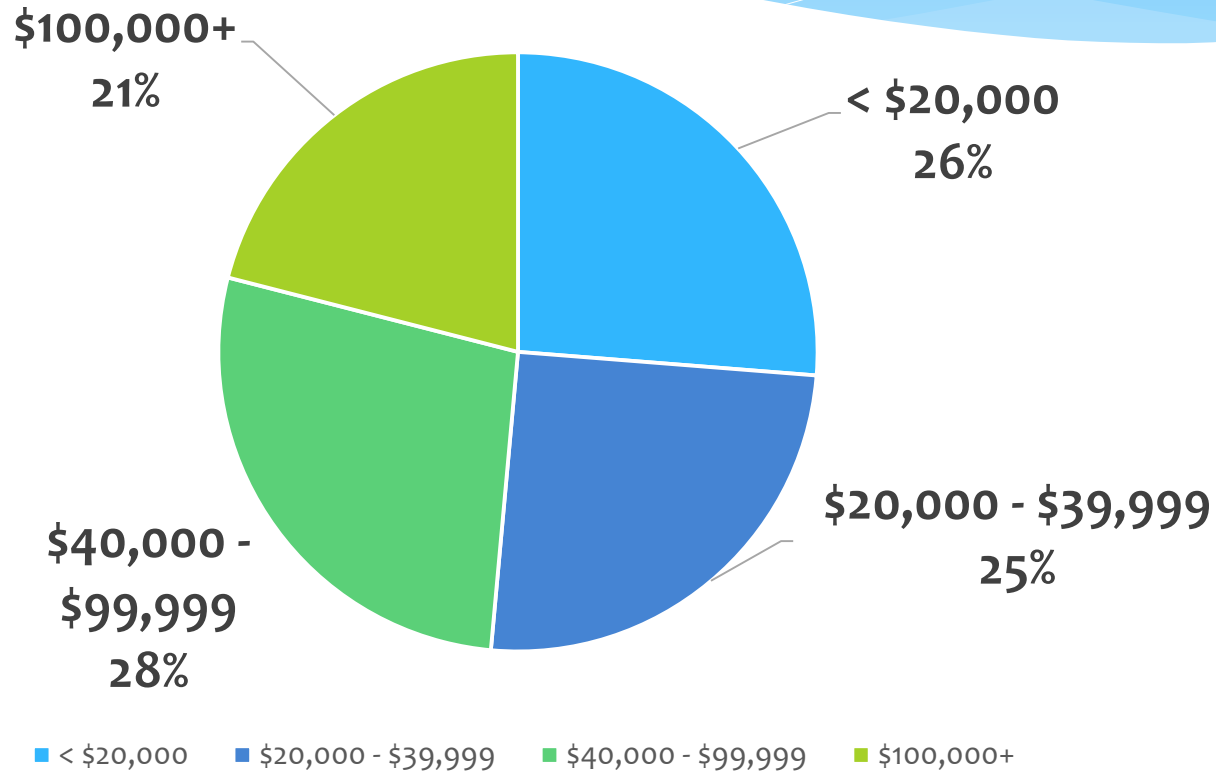
Range of Awards: \$4,000 to <\$2.7M (Median: ~ \$40,000)
